

## **Creagh College: Policy re Repeat of Leaving Certificate.**

Students are eligible to apply to the board of management for sanction to repeat the Leaving Cert. The following conditions will apply:

1. Applications from students currently attending 6<sup>th</sup> year will not be entertained until AFTER they have sat the Leaving Cert and received their results.
2. The DES regulations must be complied with.
3. A suitable vacancy must exist within the year group.
4. Applicants must accept that not all current subject combinations can be accommodated: repeat students may not be able to take all of their preferred subjects if the timetable or class sizes do not permit.
5. Repeat students must attend all classes and activities scheduled for them and will be subject to the same regulations and school rules as all other students regarding behaviour, uniform and attendance.
6. A repeat student who may not be timetabled for some subjects will be required to be in a supervised situation during all class periods. This may involve attending classes in a subject they are not studying.
7. Applicants to repeat 6<sup>th</sup> year must have settled all outstanding accounts with the school before their application will be considered by the board.
8. Applicants to repeat the Leaving Cert must have a satisfactory prior record with regard to work ethic, behaviour and attendance.
