Way2Pay Online Payment System

Way2Pay is an online payment system utilised by Creagh College through Waterford Wexford Education and Training Board.

For efficiency and security, we strive in so far as possible to be a cashless school and several significant payments are collected via this system. Some of these are detailed below.

For the system to operate a user id and password has to be created and this will be sent by SMS to the mobile number we have on file for this purpose. This user id and password is different and separate from those used to log-in to Vsware, which is the database we use for school reports, attendance and optional subjects.

Unfortunately, because of the operation of two separate databases it takes a little time to get Way2Pay operational at the beginning of the academic year. We expect to have it up and running by the end of the week commencing Mon Oct 7th after which parents can utilise the system to pay the bills below.

Additional Costs: €30 for each year except 1st years and TYs. This covers sms messaging, personal accident insurance, school journal, locker rental and printing costs etc.

Additional Costs, 1st Years: €60. As above, but also including Maths Geometry set, Maths calculator and hard back copies for certain subjects etc.

TY Fees: €400 per student. Covers bonding trip, visiting speakers, additional costs as above and subsidies for trips during the school year. Some additional charges may apply for some trips (eg. Theatre tickets etc).

Mock Exam Fees: 3rd and 6th Years. €100. Covers exam papers and corrections for 3rd year and 6th year students. (Discounts apply for siblings)

Book Rental Scheme, 5th Years only in 2019/20: This year we have introduced a Book Rental Scheme for 5th year students, the cost of which will be €100pa for participating students.

Evening Study: €180 per term.

School tours will also generally be collected for via Way2Pay.

Subject specific fees: Typically, we seek a contribution from parents towards the cost of art packs for Art students and materials for Woodwork and Metalwork students. These will be advised to the students by the teachers concerned.
