## OUR SELF-EVALUATION REPORT AND IMPROVEMENT PLAN

***In the last year, we have looked at teaching and learning in our school to find out what we are doing well. This is what we discovered:***

Our current reporting practices should be reviewed in order to align them with Junior Cycle assessment moments and include the language of learning and formative feedback.

Subject departments would like to become more proficient in the use of a shared collaborative space such as the Microsoft Office suite (Teams) to assist with collaborative planning.

The staff in Creagh College continues to grow significantly. Positive student-teacher relationships are very important and to support our Code of Positive Behaviour, teachers should receive continuous training in Restorative Practice. New teachers should be trained in RP also.

***This is what we did to find out what we were doing well, and what we could do better:***

Current third year parents and students were surveyed.

Staff were asked to identify key areas of improvement in teaching and learning.

Staff, in their subject departments carried out a SWOT analysis and identified their strengths as well as areas for improvement.

Senior and Middle management conducted a SWOT analysis the Leadership and Management domains from the LAOS 2016 framework.

***This is what we are now going to work on:***

We aim to improve reporting, with specific focus on second and third year students. CBA information will be included on reports. Language in line with the Junior Cycle framework and features of quality will be used. An effort to include more formative and constructive feedback in reports will be made.

Staff have and will continue to engage in training in the use of Onedrive and Teams. Digital learning plan commenced.

Staff will engage in initial and continued staff training in Restorative Practice. Core restorative practice team will engage in more training. Staff will implement a restorative approach when working with students.

***This is what you can do to help:***

Provide feedback, where necessary on changes to reporting and how effective these are.

Support and facilitate the restoratives approaches used in the school to resolves conflict.
